WHERE

WHY

Behavior referrals, truancy, and poor academic performance

GOAL

Work with students to help them succeed and stay in their district school

SENIORS PLUS

GRADES >12

WHERE

District Schools/ Community colleges

WHY

Students didn't graduate with their class

GOAL

Help slightly older students earn their diploma and set them up for success

IN-PERSON

GRADES 6 – 12

WHERE

West40 Safe Schools

WHY

Continued behavior referrals, truancy, &poor academic performance despite interventions

GOAL

Empower students to recognize & use their strengths to meet goals, using a heavy focus on social-emotional & academic support

VIRTUAL

GRADES 4 – 12

WHERE

Virtual school

WHY

Medically or emotionally fragile

GOAL

Partner with home districts to reconnect students, using a heavy focus on social-emotional and academic support

RSSP

GRADES 6 – 12

West40 Safe Schools

WHY

Suspension, expulsion eligible, and/or expelled

GOAL

Empower students to recognize and use their strengths to meet goals, using a heavy focus on social-emotional and academic support



In the 2022-23 school year:

We served 62 schools and our student services staff now consists of 123 team members, including teachers, advocates, liaisons, social workers, behavior interventionists, counselors, and program leaders.

- Our Remote School has served more than 70 students from across West Cook and North Cook County.
- 385 students have received support with attendance needs via our *Truancy Program*.
- Our West40 ALOP had 600 students successfully graduate.
- West40 advocates supported over 2800 students.




