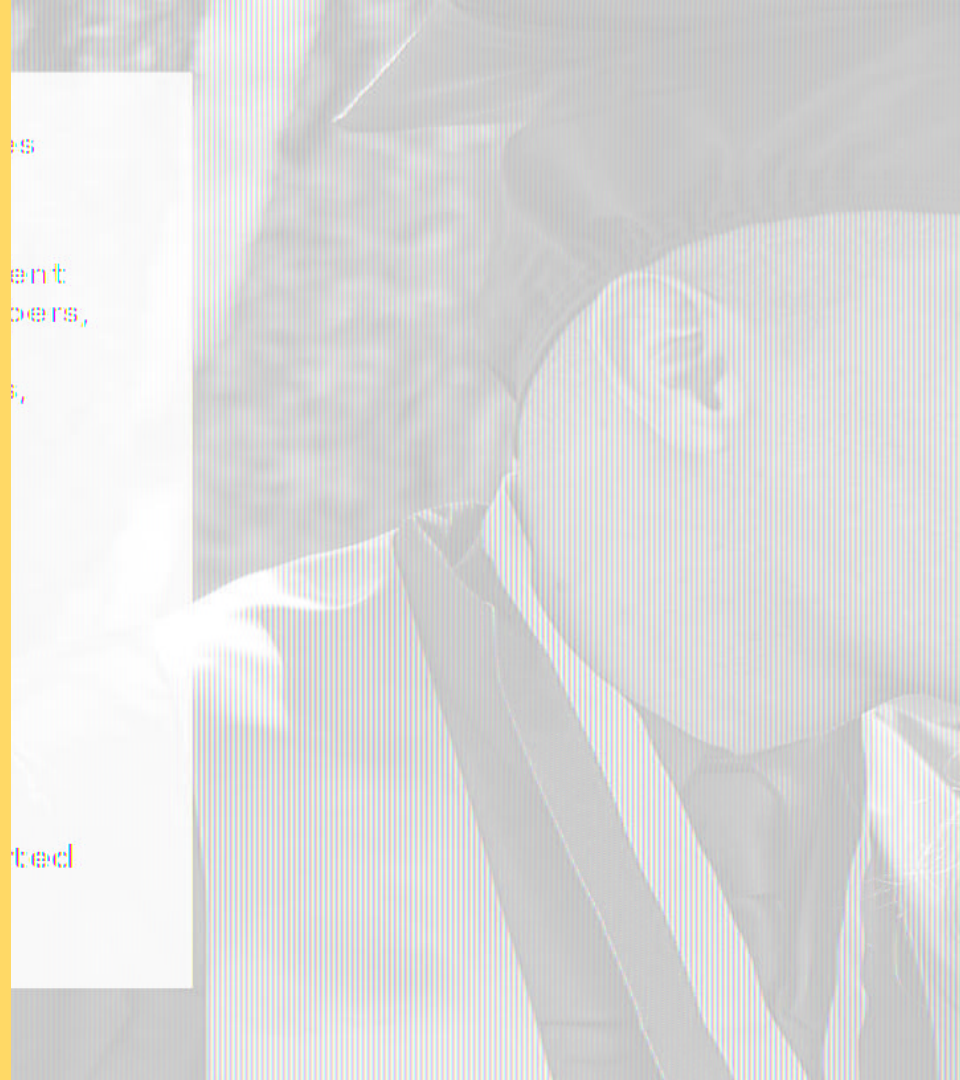

In the 2022-23 school year:

We served *62 schools* and our student services staff now consists of *123 team members*, including teachers, advocates, liaisons, social workers, behavior interventionists, counselors, and program leaders.

- Our *Remote School* has served more than 70 students from across West Cook and North Cook County.
- 385 students have received support with attendance needs via our *Truancy Program*.
- Our West40 ALOP had 600 students successfully graduate.
- West40 advocates supported over 2800 students.

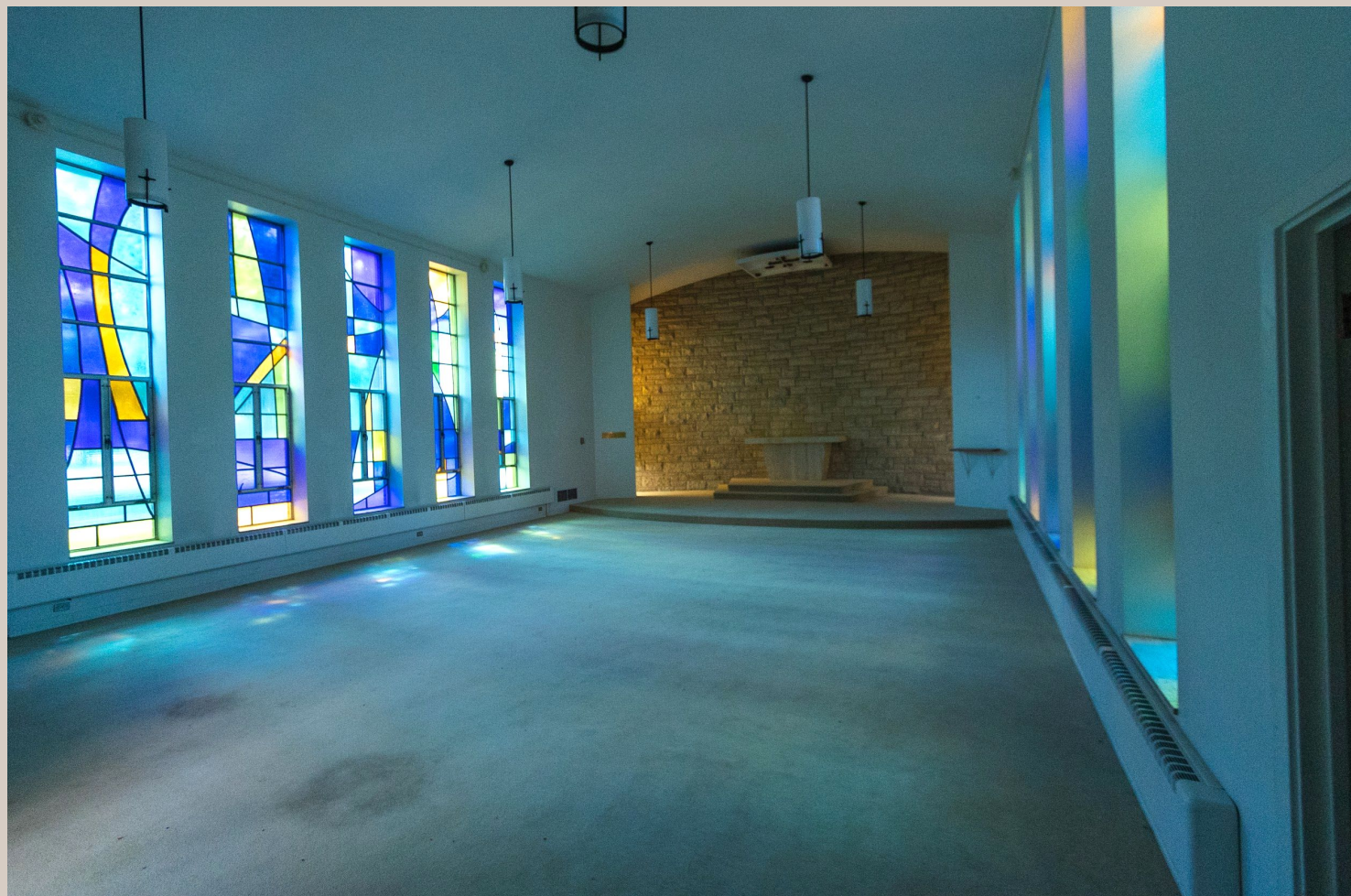


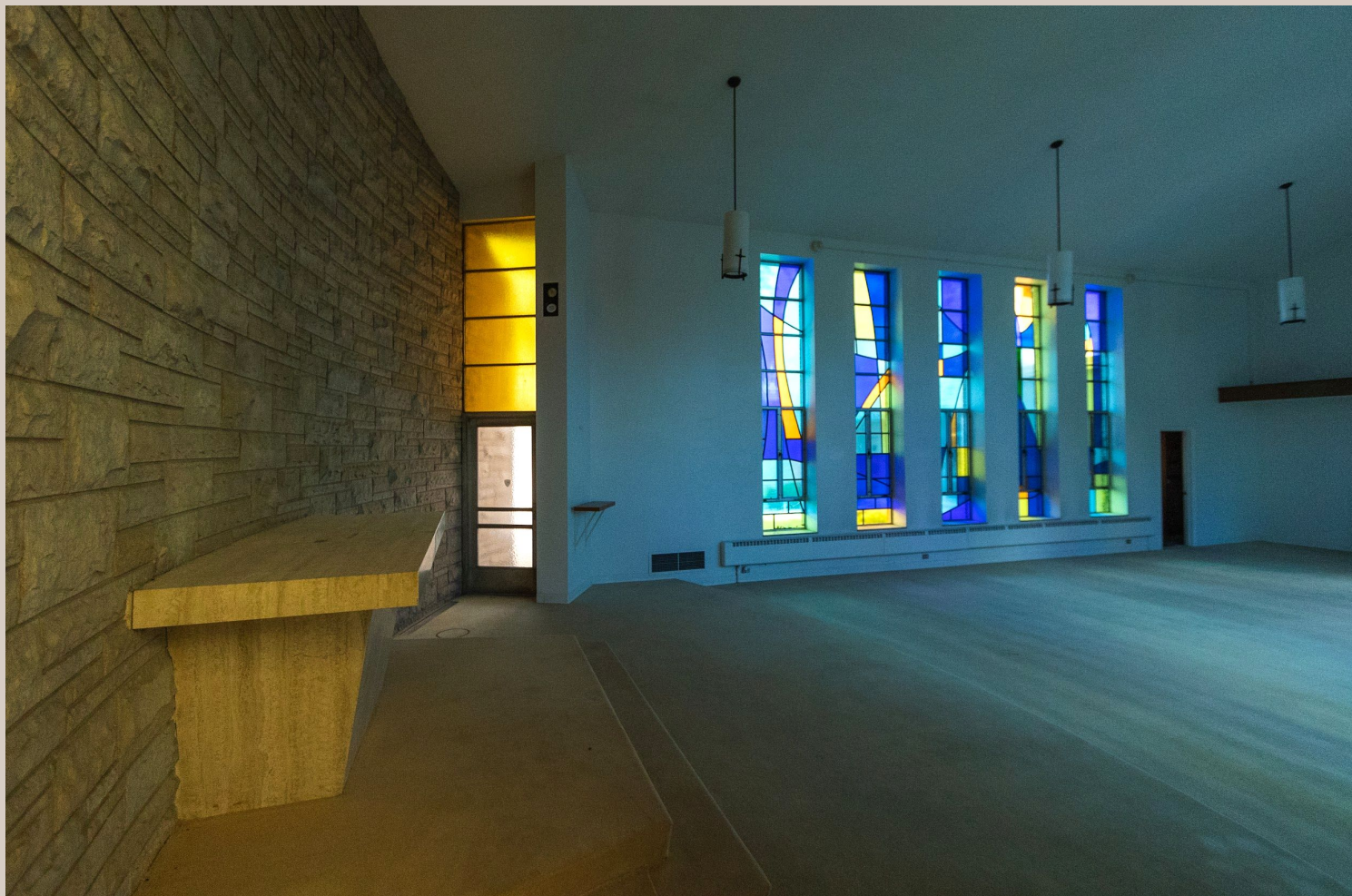
